Getting to know PSDF



Our purpose-You will be part of the largest skills development fund in Pakistan. Punjab Skills Development Funds' purpose is to shape the future and well-being of the poor and vulnerable youth by giving them access to skills training of the highest standard so they can find sustainable employment and income-generating opportunities in Pakistan and beyond.

The impact we have created-PSDF started its operations in the 4 poorest districts of Punjab through its FCDO, funded programme. Since 2016, The geographical remit has expanded to the entire 36 districts of Punjab. PSDF has funded the skills training of almost 300,000+ underprivileged youth across Punjab, which includes 180,000+ male and 110,000+ female graduates. These graduates have been trained in approximately 250 demand-driven and market relevant trades across 10 sectors.

PSDF works closely and collaboratively with some of the largest international donors and organisations such as the **World Economic Forum**, **UNICEF**, **FCDO**, **ILO**, and **World Bank**. Through its partnership with the World Economic Forum, PSDF has set up Parwaaz, National Accelerator on Closing the Skills Gap in Pakistan. Parwaaz (https://parwaaz.com/) is the most powerful skilling platform of Pakistan, with strong ties with the most influential business leaders across 6 large and high-growth sectors. PSDF also signed a partnership agreement with **UNICEF** as its Implementing Partner for executing a large-scale research project on Out-Of-School Adolescents.

How the Role looks like

You will report to <u>Manager Research Policy and Donor Management (RPDM)</u>. The candidate will actively support development, management, execution, and successful delivery of <u>research and knowledge-based projects</u> for large international donors within <u>exceptional quality assurance</u> parameters. Based on PSDF's research agenda, candidate will work with research partners and coordinate between PSDF departments to collect, prepare, analyze, evaluate data, and contribute to the publication of reports and policy recommendations.

The primary job responsibilities for this role will be carried out under guidance and supervision of the Manager Research, Policy and Donor Management.

Research Management

- Carry out **literature reviews and secondary research** to support **content generation** that is well articulated and assured for quality and editorial excellence.
- Support in developing quality assured research concept papers, ToRs, Expression of Interest and Request for Proposal documents along with well-designed research approach and methodology, survey tools, and study deliverables.
- Support in development of comprehensive and realistic project plans, with clearly defined activities and project milestones
- Support in analyzing and synthesizing quantitative and qualitative data trends, insights and
 evidence generated through research studies/knowledge-based projects and support in development
 of quality assured research study reports. Proficiency in softwares' such as STATA, SPSS, MS Excel
 will be preferred.

Donor Management

- Support in donor reporting and management through proactively collecting and organizing
 information on programme targets and milestones from internal departments on PSDF skills
 schemes, projects, and initiatives.
- Support in development of **periodic progress reports for international donor funded programmes,** on monthly, quarterly, and annual basis.
